






Chronic Neutropenia Study Seeks Volunteers

This is a Phase 1b/2 clinical research study, or clinical trial. This study will help researchers learn more about the investigational study medicine, mavorixafor, and how it may impact people living with chronic neutropenia.

About the Study

-  Chronic neutropenia is a rare blood disorder, marked by having a low number of neutrophils, a type of white blood cell.*
-  The investigational study medicine, mavorixafor, is taken orally (in capsules). It is not an injection.
-  The study will determine if mavorixafor, the study medication:
 - Is well-tolerated
 - May increase neutrophil cell counts

Why Take Part?

- Chronic neutropenia is a disease with few treatment options. More treatment options are needed.
- Clinical studies are required to make sure a medicine is safe and works before it is approved for use by the FDA.
- Talk to your doctor and find out if this study is an option for you.

Who Can Join the Study?

- Age 12 and older
- Diagnosis of chronic neutropenia (including congenital, idiopathic, and cyclic)
- Either on or off Granulocyte colony-stimulating factor (G-CSF) treatment

What Does the Study Involve?

Duration:

This is a two-part study that will last 7-9 months.

Cost:

Study-related treatments and procedures are provided at no cost to participants. If needed, approved travel and lodging will be reimbursed by the study sponsor, X4 Pharmaceuticals.
